EAST ANGLIA ART FUND GRANTS

Advice for applicants

The East Anglia Art Fund grants a small number of applications for funds at their meetings in March and October each year. Grants of up to £1,000 are awarded to enable a greater range of exhibition and art education work in our region. We primarily fund activity in Norfolk and Suffolk but also consider applications from Essex and Cambridgeshire. Only in exceptional circumstances will a grant exceeding £1,000 be offered.

Please note that as our funds are limited, unfortunately not all applications meeting our criteria can be successful.

Who we fund:

- Organisations and individuals who are making art exhibitions or developing work with artists and young people in the context of art exhibitions. There is no minimum duration for an exhibition, but audience impact will be considered.
- For a list of those projects recently funded, visit the current and forthcoming exhibitions and events pages of the East Anglia Art Fund website.

What we fund:

- Exhibitions of contemporary or historic art curated for public art galleries, libraries and other spaces, including industrial spaces, churches and historic buildings.
- Work with artists and young people or adults, based on an engagement with an art exhibition or that has an exhibition as its outcome.
- We support work which is interdisciplinary, but there must be a core visual arts element.

What we do not fund:

- Work not based in the visual arts.
- Exhibitions that are part of a core programme in an established commercial gallery.
- Solo exhibitions or projects developed by an artist focussed on their own work.
- Work with artists in schools or colleges.
- Exhibitions in a private house that is not routinely open to the public.
- Performance-based work without an exhibition or art education element.
- The purchase of art works.
- Projects that are already live or commence within 8 weeks of the application submission.

Projects and applicant organisations will not normally be supported for more than 3 consecutive years.

Applications should arrive by January 31 for consideration at the March meeting and by August 31 for consideration at the October meeting. Applicants will be informed of the decision made by the end of the month in which the meeting is held. Free entry for EAAF members to the project in receipt of funding is usually a condition of a grant.
