You are ineligible to be a Trustee if any of the following applies to you: You have an IVA, debt relief order or bankruptcy order; You have been removed as a trustee in England, Scotland or Wales (by the Charity Commission or Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator); You have been removed from being in the management or control of any body in Scotland (under relevant legislation); You have been disqualified by the Charity Commission; You are a disqualified company director; You are a designated person for the purposes of anti-terrorism legislation; You are on the sex offenders register; You have been found in contempt of court for making (or causing to be made) a false statement; You have been found guilty of disobedience to an order or direction of the Charity Commission.

You may still be eligible to be a Trustee if the following applies to you: You have an unspent criminal conviction; You have an outstanding county court judgement against you; You have been removed as a Trustee or volunteer in any capacity or country; You have failed a DBS check. If any of these applies to you, please supply further details with your application.
